

Controlled Technology/Technical Data License Compliance Attestation For H-1B and O-1A Petitions

Deemed Export Background Information

Technology/technical data, software and/or defense services are considered to be exported not only under the traditional sense of shipping and/or providing the Technology/technical data, software and defense services overseas; an export can also be "deemed" to take place when technology/technical data, software and/or defense services is released and/or provided to a foreign national within the United States. Deemed exports must be authorized through an export license issued by the responsible Government agency. Technology/technical data, software and/or defense services are considered "released" for export when they are "available to foreign nationals for visual inspection (such as reading technical specifications, plans, blueprints, etc.); exchanged orally; or are made available by practice or application under the guidance of persons with knowledge of the technology/technical data."
