

Application Materials: Tell Your Unique Story!

- Don't miss out on your best chance and first impression to highlight your experiences and accomplishments.
- Do Your Research- The UF's Teams Titles page, Colleges' and Units' websites, and Careers at UF job postings are your roadmap.
- Be a detective/do your homework, revisit your career portfolio before your ever start your application- Compile list of keywords, transferable skillsets, qualifications, values.
- Start with A Blank slate!

Resume Checklist

Key Areas to include on Resume:

- **Contact information**
- Objective/Goal Statement Remember your UVP!
- Professional Experience ONLY 4-5 bullet points
- Education
- Training/Certifications
- Skills Hard or Technical
- Awards/Accomplishments
- Publications/Notable Works

Digging Deeper - Professional Experience

Format Resume Bullets into **Star Stories** (only 4-5 bullet points)



Example:

Coached and counseled underperforming staff by creating a performance improvement plan that leveraged employee resources such as employee benefits and EAP, resulting in improved performance for 75 employees.

Cover Letter

Don't miss out on your best chance and first impression to highlight your experiences and accomplishments.

- ✓ Contact Information: Name, Email address, Phone number, Address/Location, Date sent
- ✓ 1st Paragraph: The Why Why do you want the role and why are you uniquely qualified?
- ✓ 2nd 3rd Paragraphs: Work Experience Connect the dots from your resume and fill in any gaps. Opportunity to display transferable skills.
- ✓ Closing: Conclude with tying back into your UVP, your interest and your why.

Pre-Interview Preparation

Values

Identify job requirements and align your values to those requirements

Elevator Speech

Highlight key achievements that fulfill employer's need











WORK CULTURE

Become familiar with the UF unit & its culture

Alignment

Prepare to speak positively and authentically about how your experience and qualifications align with the job

Mock Interviews

Prepare for the interview with a friend or peers

Pre-Interview Preparation - Questions

Share specific examples of when you faced a particular situation or challenge and how you navigated it.



A common mistake interviewees make is being general in their answers and not fully answering the question, especially when they are asked to give specific examples. This impacts the interviewer's ability to learn about you and form a positive impression of your skills, abilities, and competencies.

During the Interview

- Be sure to speak to your value proposition -
 - "I will be a great contributor and here is how..."
- Watch your cues
 - Verbal: speaking rate (too fast vs too slow), filler words (i.e., um's)
 - Non-verbal: maintain eye contact, calm tone of voice
- Be succinct, clear, and to the point with your answers
- Don't fall into the trap of venting about your present/past employers





- Ask questions to express your interest in the position
 - o "Why is this position vacant?"
 - o "What skills or qualities are most important to success in this role?"
 - o "What are some challenges you think the successful candidate will face in this role?"
 - o "How does this role contribute to the overall company goals?"
 - o "How would you describe the culture and work environment for the company or team?"
- Wrap up the interview by thanking everyone for the opportunity and highlight a couple of your qualifications

Wrap-up:

Send a "Thank You" letter or card

(Do this within 24 hours of the interview)

Reaffirm your interest

Highlight value or key point from the interview
