


## Accessing the Online Application for a SUSORP Retirement Distribution


The electronic version of the SUSORP Retirement Distribution form can be accessed by visiting the following website: [www.frs.fl.gov](http://www.frs.fl.gov).

Registered users may login by entering their credentials in the designated fields and clicking the “Log in Securely” button. Registered users who have forgotten or lost their usernames or passwords should use the “Forgot Login” link.

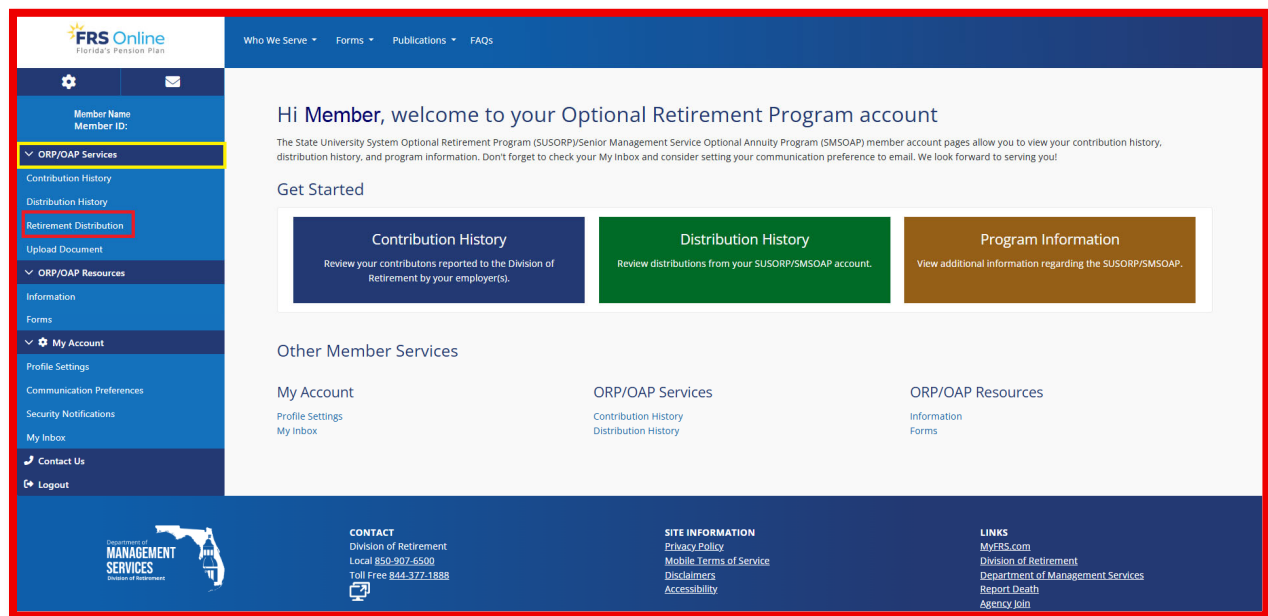
Unregistered users may start the registration process by clicking the “Create Account” link under the “Log in Securely” button or the “Register Here” button on the slideshow.
